



**DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY WITH FLOURINATED GREENHOUSE GAS
REGULATION (EU) NO 2024/573 OF THE
EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL AS AMENDED**

We, Delta Development Team INC declare under our sole responsibility that when placing on the market pre-charged equipment which we import to the EU and not falling under the prohibitions referred to in Article 11(1), the hydrofluorocarbons contained in that equipment are accounted for within the quota system referred to in Chapter IV of Regulation (EU) No 2024/573.

Delta's statement on compliance with EU and F-gas legislation No 2024/573 ;

1. Delta does not import more than 100 tonne CO₂ equivalent of HFC in equipment per year and is therefore exempt from registration, quota and reporting per Article 26.1, therefore we do not require authorisation issued in accordance with Article 21(2), referred to in Article 17 of that Regulation, to use the quota of an importer of hydrofluorocarbons subject to Article 15 of based on the quantity of hydrofluorocarbons contained in the equipment.
2. Delta's refrigeration products do not fall under any prohibition of Annex IV on the following basis:
 - The units are not considered domestic.
 - The units are not considered commercial.
 - The units are not considered stationary.

Therefore the products are not covered by points 2,3 of Annex IV and the equipment presented does not fall under the prohibitions referred to in Article 11(1) and are appropriately labelled in accordance with Article 12.

3. Delta uses a insulation foaming agent that complies with 2024/573 Annex IV point 17 stipulation of less than 150 gwp.
